MEDICINE SUBSPECIALTY CONFERENCES & COURSES

All Sub-specialties:

For advanced trainees the following are considered requirements for training

- Annual attendance at local (NZ) specialty society branch or college (NZ) annual meeting (including trainee days)
- Attendance at Australasian specialty society branch or college annual meeting (including trainee days), once during advanced training. Further attendance (e.g. to present research) will require a letter of support from the relevant director of training (or Clinical Director).
- Membership of relevant Australasian specialty society

The following are recommended but require a letter of support from the relevant Head of Department

- Attendance at an international meeting (particularly if it is to present novel scientific research)
- Attendance at any other meeting if required for training purposes

➤ When **presenting research** as a **requirement of training**, provide letter of support from the Head of Department
