PAEDIATRIC ADVANCED TRAINEES

Textbooks to be reimbursed for advanced paediatric trainees will be considered on a case by case basis in consultation with their supervisor – letter of support required.

Other courses and conferences as required by the relevant SAC will be reimbursable when accompanied by a letter of support and a copy of the College training requirement from the Physician Training Handbook.

SENIOR REGISTRAR CLAUSE:

Registrars in their 5th and higher years of the salary scale, and from 1 July 2009, those registrars who have successfully completed the first part of their vocational training examination requirements and a further 12 months service (it is not intended that RMOs will access this provision until their 3rd year of registrar training) are entitled to:

- A total of six days additional leave to attend appropriate conferences. Entitled registrars shall receive a maximum of \$6,000 expenses in total in respect of the total conference leave provided for in this clause.
- A maximum of three days conference leave and \$3,000 expenses may be taken in any one year.

A letter of support from your Director of Training confirming the conference you wish to attend is appropriate will be required.
